 - i. Add better access to interstate highways
 - ii. "As we are completing the bridge in Chester we will see people looking for routes from southwest up to east & we are just a year away from bridge opening
 - iii. Truck route goal is IL 57 to I-55 in MO
 - b. Preliminary Purpose Statement Feedback from CAG:
 - i. Eliminate negotiating turns for tractor/trailer in municipalities not sure if that should be spelled out
 - 1. Noted that geometric deficiencies included in Problem Statement would encapsulate this
 - ii. Work freight bottlenecks into this
 - iii. It is saying to improve travel time reliability is this different than decreasing the travel time? I'm one of those that would like to see it take 45 minutes instead
 - iv. When we are working with freight industry, they have criteria for reliability AND efficiency (how fast they can get there)
 - c. Preliminary Needs Statement Feedback from CAG:
 - i. Something I hear from farm operators is that they are interested in 4-lane rural expressway that takes into consideration their farm equipment needs that are both safe & efficient for the farmers
 - ii. On roadway deficiencies I'd like to see something mentioned there about lack of shoulders very problematic
